1-strip plank, iroko is a hard wood in yellow-brown colour, sometimes with variegated markings following to the drying.

Since the planks have a large format, the finish may show signs of sapwood, colour variations and marked veins.

Over time the chromatic oxidation process will harmonize the surface colour.
