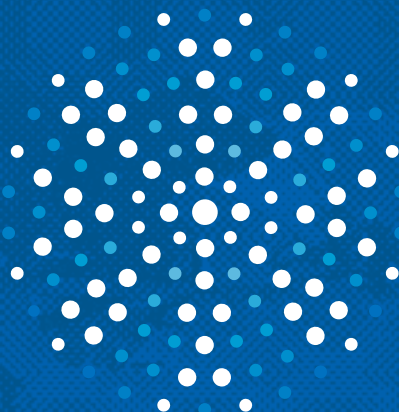

Due to Covid-19 restrictions, no gym is available for teams.

DEADLINE FOR TEAM ENTRIES

The Organisers are only allowed to accept entries submitted within the communicated deadlines and through the FIS online entry system.

PRELIMINARY ENTRIES

Announcement of team size **16.12.2021**

Each National Ski Association has to announce to the Organisers the expected total number of team members (competitors, coaches, accompanying persons and service personnel) five (5) weeks before the first event.

FINAL ENTRIES

Definitive registration **13.01.2022**

The Organizers must be informed latest seven (7) days before the official 1st training (speed) or event (tech) about the names of the team members, eventual changes to the arrival date and the originally registered size of team (incl. officials and service personnel according to art. 4.3), as well as an eventual withdrawal from the event. If this is not done, the Organizing Committee will invoice the costs incurred for cancelled accommodation (art. 4) to the National Association concerned.

ACCOMMODATION

Official arrival day **19.01.2022**

Official departure day **24.01.2022**

Accommodation will be provided in Cortina, maximum 10 minutes' drive from the race area. Accommodation will be paid by the OC according to FIS rules. Team Captains will attend the accommodation desk to check the free nights for their athletes and officials. A voucher with the calculation of free night will be provided and at the same time communicated to the hotel. All extras (alcoholic drinks, laundry, other services), as well as extra nights (early arrival, team members exceeding quotas) must be paid directly to the hotel. Any other guest or accompanying person who has no right for accommodation will have to pay directly to the hotel.

TRAVEL EXPENSES (art. 5)

The OC will pay to the participating teams the travel expenses for the best 45 competitors on the valid starting list who started in the race. Payments are based on the belonging group of countries (art. 5.1) and will be done directly on the NSA bank account.

PRIZE MONEY

Prize money will be paid directly to the athlete's personal bank account. Italian tax laws will be applied.

COURSE ACCESS

Course access will be handed out at the race office before the Team Captains' Meeting.

TEAM HOSPITALITY

Team Hospitality is located at Duca d'Aosta. Access is guaranteed only to accredited athletes, officials and SRS, belonging to the "red bubble".

COVID 19 MEASURES

Eligible to participate in the event are vaccinated persons, who can prove by certification issued by their National Health Authorities:

- the completed vaccine cycle (considered "Fully Vaccinated"), not later than 9 months or with third dose "booster" always within and not later than 9 months;
- the recovery from Sars-Cov-2 infection not later than 6 months.

For EU Citizens or Residents you'll can produce the Enhanced Green Pass (valid in Italy).

Not EU Citizens cannot get the enhanced Green Pass, because this is possible only for vaccinations recognized in the EU (BioNtech/Pfizer, AstraZeneca, Moderna, Janssen Pharmaceutica NV - Johnson & Johnson).

In such cases you will be asked to present your vaccination certificate or a medical certificate of recovery (please note that these documents must be produced in original. Digital certificates will not be accepted!), with English or German translation.

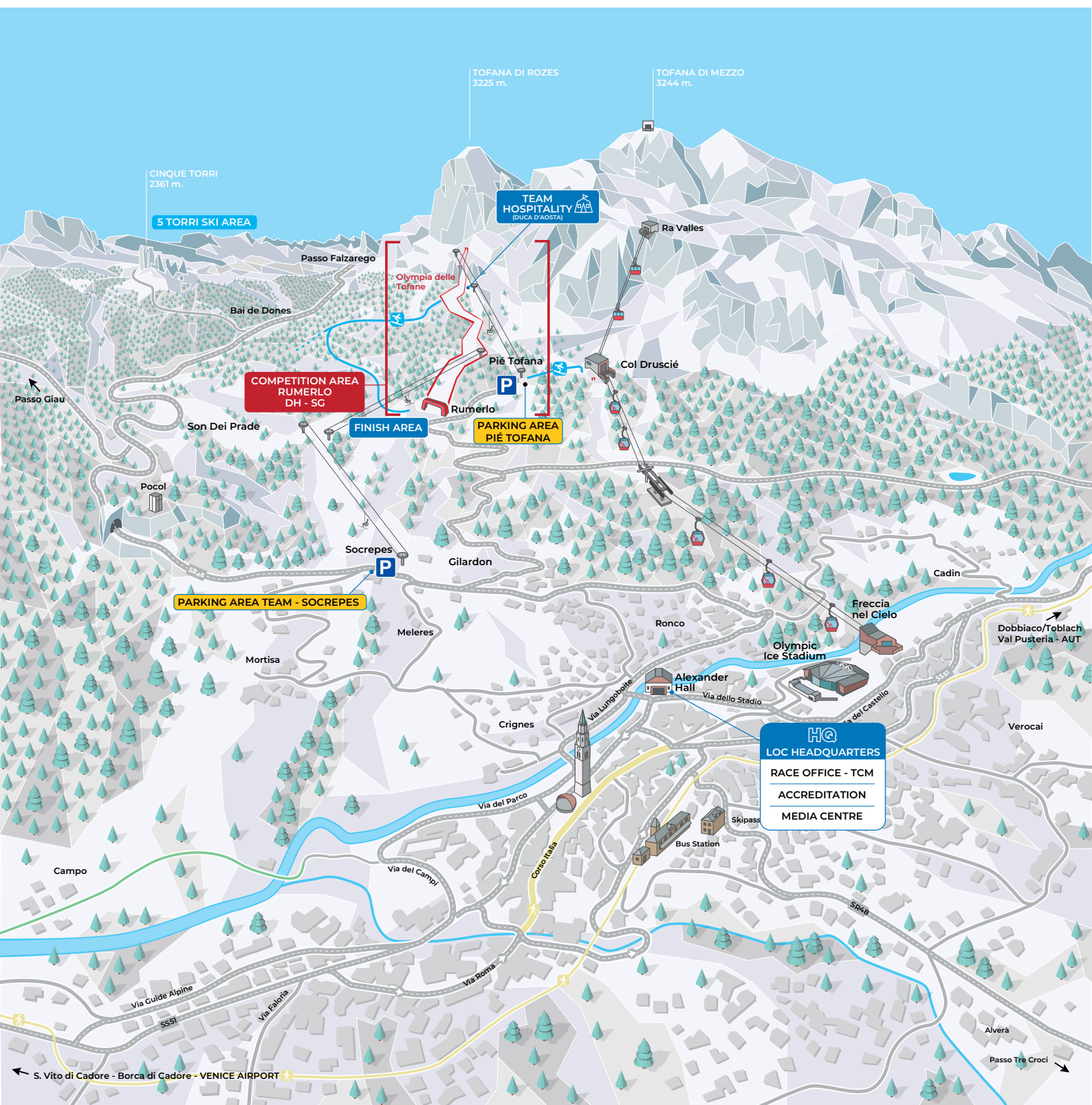
For all it's mandatory a negative RT-PCR oro-naso-pharyngeal test, not older than 48 hrs prior to collecting the accreditation in Cortina d'Ampezzo.

Due to the development of the pandemic wave, the LOC reserves to adopt more restricted measures or to request C-19 re-testing in Cortina d'Ampezzo.

The full Covid-19 protocol, in its early version, will be available by the beginning of 2022.

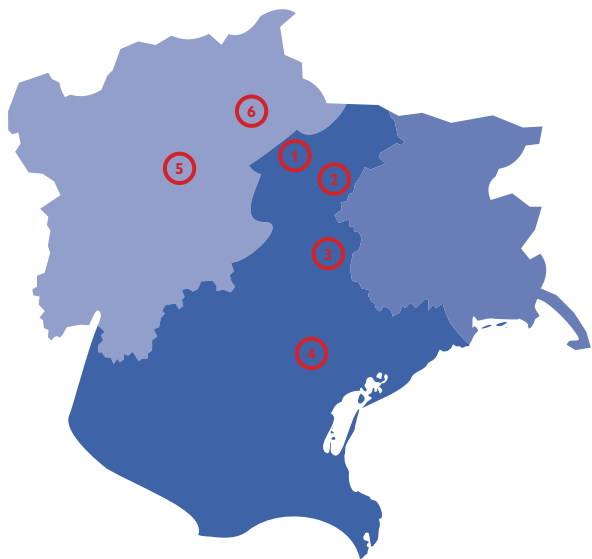
PARKING AREAS FOR TEAMS

The main parking area for teams is at Pié Tofana and other parking spaces are available at Socrepes. Parking permits will be distributed at the Race Office upon arrival and according to team size. Free parking at the hotels.

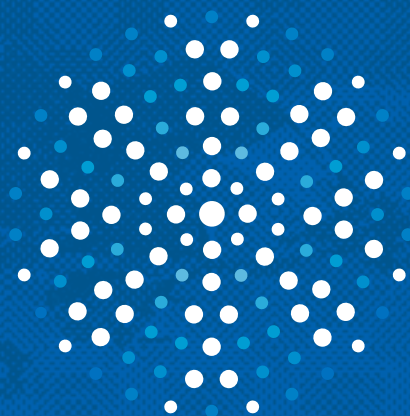
