



# **COVID-19 PREVENTION PROTOCOL** Nordic Combined 2021 Val di Fiemme **GUIDELINES FOR MEDIA**



The outbreak of the Covid-19 Pandemic has affected all our lives, and also the whole world of sport has been influenced by this health worldwide emergency, that all the organisers of sport events have to face with proper and specific rules. Because of the development of the Coronavirus infection all over the world during the year 2020, many Covid-19 related restrictions will be fixed also by the OC Fiemme World Cup.

The OC, in order to minimize the risk of infection, has established that no spectators and no guests will be allowed to enter the competitions' venues and there won't' be any side events program. Neither normal nor virtual press conferences will be held.

The long weekend of the FIS Nordic Combined World Cup in Val di Fiemme will take place with enhanced safety measures.

According to the national and local provisions regarding the Covid-19 protection and to FIS Covid-19 prevention guidelines, the OC ha set up a specific protocol with some rules that all the stakeholders involved in our events have strictly to follow.

By making the request of an accreditation, every person accepts the content of this Protocol.

### **BASICS**

Individual responsibility is the most important aspect for the safety of everyone. Everybody must follow the basic hygiene measures, to prevent the spread of Covid-19 infection:

- 1. Keep the minimum distance of 1m
- 2. Wear a mask always inside and outside
- Wash and disinfect frequently your hands 3.

Anybody who should show symptoms of Covid-19 during the event must contact the immediately the OC, informing the Press Office Staff.











# **JOURNEY TO VAL DI FIEMME**

Before coming to Val di Fiemme please visit the Italian Ministry website > to be updated regarding the travel restrictions.

Do not travel to Val di Fiemme if you have symptoms of Covid-19.

During your stay in Val di Fiemme, please try to avoid any contact with other people outside the competition venue.

# HOTEL

The OC can help you with finding the accommodation for the event. Inquiries must be sent to alessia.baudin@visitfiemme.it

Prices for accommodation in hotels in Val di Fiemme:

Double room single use – starting from 88 € / night (B&B treatment)

Double room – starting from 63 € / night (B&B treatment)

During your stay in the hotel, you must follow the hygiene measures established by the local authorities for the tourist accommodation.

# **ACCREDITATION**

According to the FIS Covid-19 Prevention Protocol Guideline and the Italian Government provisions, the number of Media accreditations that the OC Fiemme World Cup can accept is limited.

The accreditation request for all media (press, photo, TV & Radio) must be sent directly to the OC, filling in the request form here >

All accreditations can be released only as soon as the OC receives all the necessary and compulsory documents, that are:

 A negative Covid-19 test, that must be not older than 72 hours before your arrival at the competition venue (that means that it must be not older than 72 hours at the day when you collect your accreditation).

A copy of the negative test must be uploaded on your FIS Passport, where you also have to fill out the whereabouts and the health questionnaire. It is fundamental that you upload the test before your arrival at the Ski Jumping Stadium in Predazzo.

Once the OC receives the negative test together with the health questionnaire and the whereabouts, through the FIS Passport, we will check all the information sent, and if everything is correct, you will get an e-mail with the confirmation of your accreditation request. When you come to the Ski Jumping Stadium, you can show this confirmation e-mail to the OC access control staff. Showing this e-mail you can enter the main access of the stadium, but then, in order to have access to the Media Center and the other facilities inside the stadium, you have to go to the accreditation office and pick up your accreditation.

For big TV companies, please note that only one representative can come to the accreditation office to pick up all the accreditations for the entire group.

Together with your accreditation you will also get the Media parking pass.

## **TRANSPORT**

Due to the travel restriction, the OC Fiemme World Cup is not able to offer a transfer service for Media for this edition of the FIS Nordic Combined World Cup.

- Main Media Center Predazzo 40 working spaces
- **Sub Press Center Lago di Tesero 20 working spaces**

Each person will have to choose one working space at the beginning of the event and keep it for the whole weekend.
