







COVID-19 PREVENTION PROTOCOL Nordic Combined 2021 Val di Fiemme GUIDELINES FOR TEAMS



The **outbreak of the Covid-19 Pandemic** has affected all our lives, and also the whole world of sport has been influenced by this health worldwide emergency, that all the organisers of sport events have to face with proper and specific rules. Because of the development of the Coronavirus infection all over the world during the year 2020, **many Covid-19 related restrictions will be fixed also by the OC Fiemme World Cup**.

The OC, in order to minimize the risk of infection, has established **that no spectators and no guests** will be allowed to enter the competitions' venues and there won't' be any side events program. Neither normal nor virtual press conferences will be held.

The Nordic Combined World Cup competitions in Val di Fiemme will take place with enhanced safety measures.

According to the national and local provisions regarding the Covid-19 protection and to FIS Covid-19 prevention guidelines, the OC has set up a specific protocol with some rules that all the stakeholders involved in our events have strictly to follow.

Every person that gets an accreditation for the event, has to accept the content of this Protocol.

BASICS

Individual responsibility is the most important aspect for the safety of everyone. Everybody must follow the basic hygiene measures, to prevent the spread of Covid-19 infection:

- 1. Keep the minimum distance of 1m
- 2. Wear a mask always inside and outside
- 3. Wash and disinfect frequently your hands

JOURNEY TO VAL DI FIEMME

Before coming to Val di Fiemme please visit the <u>Italian Ministry website ></u> to be updated regarding the travel restrictions.

Do not travel to Val di Fiemme if you have symptoms of Covid-19. During your stay in Val di Fiemme, please try to avoid any contact with other people outside the competition venue.

TRANSPORT

AIRPORT TRANSFER

Due to Covid-19 restriction the OC is not able to organise any transport from/to foreign airports; therefore, the **official airports** are **Venezia – Bergamo – Verona**.

1 transport (from and to the airport) is free of charge. For the teams that need transport from the official airports to the hotels please contact: <u>info@fiemmeworldcup.com</u>

Price for additional transport (depending on destination) will be communicated on request. No shuttle service in the valley will be organised by the OC.

For the transportation service you must follow the national regulations. The drivers are tested negative for Covid.19. Inside the cars/bus you must wear a surgical mask. The surgical mask must be put on before entering the vehicle.

ACCOMMODATION

Booking for accommodation will be done according to the FIS Rules via FIS Online registration system. The OC offers accommodation (full board included) in 3* hotels (2* and 4* on request) in Val di Fiemme from 3 to 15 km from the stadium.

PRICES

- 3* Hotel max CHF 125 per person in double room
- 2* Hotel max CHF 90 per person in double room.

Additional information about the accommodation will be given to the teams after receiving preliminary entry and accommodation request.





ACCREDITATION

The accreditation for teams/staff/technicians/officials/coaches/SRS must be requested, like in the past season, trough the **FIS online system**.

According to the FIS Covid-19 Prevention Protocol Guideline all accreditations will be released only as soon as the OC receives a negative Covid-19 PCR test of all participants. The test must be not older than 48 hours before your arrival at the competition venue. Please consider that, according to the current Italian rules, also for entering Italy you need a negative PCR test that must be not older than 48 hours when you cross the border.

COVID-19 TEST

A Covid-19 test (<u>PCR is required</u>) must be done by all athletes, team staff, officials, SRS within 48 hours before their arrival at the competition venue, and the negative result of this test must be uploaded on their FIS Passport.

Like for all other FIS competitions, please remember that you will be asked also to fill out the whereabouts and answer the health questionnaire on your FIS Passport.

If you need a PCR test before leaving Val di Fiemme, there are two private laboratories that can do this kind of test, but you have to book it in advance:

ACCREDITATION RELEASE

Once the negative test is imported from the FIS Passport into our accreditation system, a confirmation e-mail will be sent, in order to allow people to have access to the main entrance of the ski jumping stadium and pick up the accreditations at the accreditation office (you can just show the confirmation e-mail on your phone to the security staff at the entrance).

Please remember that only one team representative can pick up the accreditations, for all team members, at the accreditation office, in order to avoid any kind of gathering.

The Accreditation Office is located at the Ski Jumping Stadium in Predazzo. More information about opening times of the accreditation office <u>here ></u>

Please note that due to Covid-19 restrictions and regulations, the current situation can change very quickly and therefore the OC could be obliged to do some necessary adjustments or changes in the accreditation procedure.







COMMUNICATIONS FLOW FOR A COVID-19 POSITIVE TEST

Upon receipt of a positive test, the team/individual shall immediately inform the FIS contact person on site (Race/Contest Director). The Race Director will inform the FIS Event Task Force (one representative: FIS, LOC, NSA, and the LOC Health Coordinator, FIS C-19 Expert) of the situation, who will assess the next steps necessary. Please note these guidelines refer only to the external communication of a positive test. Informing the local authorities should follow the government guidelines in place at the time and the region.

WAXING CABINS & TEAM AREA

SKI JUMPING STADIUM PREDAZZO

Waxing cabins at the Ski Jumping Stadium in Predazzo will be available from 8:00 a.m. of Thursday 14th January.

For entering the athletes' zone every person must exhibit the local accreditation.

WAXING CABINS & TEAM AREA CROSS COUNTRY STADIUM LAGO DI TESERO

Waxing cabins at the Cross-Country Stadium in Lago di Tesero will be available from 8:00 a.m. of Thursday 14th January.

For entering the athletes' zone (Frade) every person must exhibit the local accreditation.

In order to get the accreditation **all teams/staff/technicians/officials/coaches/SRS have to do the Covid-19 test, whose result must be negative** (for any information regarding the accreditation procedure, please see the specific point).

Please consider that also the drivers of the waxing trucks will have to follow the same accreditation procedure as the team staff.

Teams are responsible for a daily cleaning of their cabin. The LOC will supply every cabin with proper cleaning tools.

TEAM HOSPITALITY

From Thursday 14th January to Sunday 17th, both at the ski jumping and cross-country stadium, all people inside the team area will have a catering service at their disposal, free of charge.

The catering will be arranged as a take-away service according to the national current rules referred to food and beverage distribution.

Everybody has to consume food and beverage exclusively inside their own changing room.

It is recommended that each team delegates a maximum of 2 people to collect the "lunch bags" for all team members, to avoid any form of gathering. The daily buffet will be served according to the national regulations in force regarding catering and will offer only single-serving products / portions. This protocol has been defined according to the **regulations updated on December 23rd 2020** and the OC reserves the right to make any necessary change if some new rules, regarding Covid-19, will be released by the national or local authorities.
