

COVID-19 PREVENTION PROTOCOL Tour de Ski 2022 Val di Fiemme **GUIDELINES FOR SUPPLIERS**





The outbreak of the Covid-19 Pandemic has been affecting all our lives for almost two years, and the whole world of sport has been strongly influenced by this health worldwide emergency, that all the organisers of sport events still have to face with proper and specific rules. Because of the development of the Coronavirus infection all over the world during the year 2020 and 2021, many Covid-19 related restrictions established by the OC Fiemme World Cup for last season will still remain valid for the season 2021/2022. Even if the situation all over the world seems to go slowly better, also thanks to the vaccination campaign, we all have to be very careful and respect scrupulously all the rules, in order to organise our events in the safest way possible.

After season 2020/2021, when spectators were not allowed to take part in our events, the OC has established that spectators and guests for the Tour de Ski 2022 and of Nordic Combined World **Cup will be allowed** to enter the competitions' venues, but in order to minimize the risk of infection there will be very careful controls.

The final stages of 16th Tour de Ski in Val di Fiemme will and the Nordic Combined World Cup events will take place with all necessary safety measures.

According to the national and local rules regarding the Covid-19 protection and to FIS Covid-19 prevention guidelines, the OC ha set up a specific protocol with some rules that all the stakeholders involved in our events have strictly to follow.

By making the request of an accreditation, every person accepts the content of this Protocol, and also the content of the FIS Covid-19 World Cup Risk Management and Testing Protocol, that you find here.

BASICS

Individual responsibility is the most important aspect for the safety of everyone. Everybody must follow the basic hygiene measures, to prevent the spread of Covid-19 infection:

- 1. Keep the minimum distance of 1m whenever possible (like established by the **Italian Ministry of Health)**
- Wear a FFP2 mask always inside and outside 2.
- 3. Wash and disinfect frequently your hands

JOURNEY TO VAL DI FIEMME

Before coming to Val di Fiemme please visit the **Italian Ministry website** > to be updated regarding the travel restrictions.

Do not travel to Val di Fiemme if you have symptoms of Covid-19.

During your stay in Val di Fiemme, please try to avoid any contact with other people outside the competition venue.

HOTEL

The OC can help you with finding the accommodation for the event. Inquiries must be sent to alessia.baudin@visitfiemme.it

During your stay in the hotel, you must follow the hygiene measures established by the local authorities for the tourist accommodation.

COVID-19 PROCEDURES

All the suppliers that will take part in our World Cup events will have to follow strictly all the following procedures:

 Have a valid "green pass", that means that people must be vaccinated against Covid, or have recovered, or have a negative test (PCR or antigen) not older than 48 hours when they pick up their accreditation. Alternatively, it is also possible to produce one of the equivalent documents (vaccination or recovery certificate, or negative Covid-19 test not older than 48 hours before you pick up your accreditation). The green pass, or one of the equivalent documents, must be valid for the entire duration of the event.

People who come with a negative test, must do it again every 48 hours, in order to keep the validity of the accreditation.

• Wear correctly the MASK

Both inside and outside, for the entire duration of your service.







ACCREDITATION

Once the Organising Committee has checked the validity of the Covid-19 documents, the accreditation can be issued. Everydoby will get a confirmation e-mail when his/her accreditation is confirmed.

Showing this confirmation emal (in paper or electronic format) to the OC staff at the entrance of both stadiums, you will have the right to enter and reach the accreditation office, where you can get your



ACCESS TO ALPE CERMIS

All accredited people will have the right to use the cable car of Alpe Cermis for free during the final stages of Tour de Ski. It will be necessary to show yor accreditation and, if requested according to the national rules, also your green pass or equivalent document.
