

## COVID-19 PROTOCOL – TEAMS AND MEDIA

All the teams and media staff participating to the Fiemme 2021 FIS Rollerski World Championships, will have to register to the **FIS Passport**, following the FIS rules, as explained in the Invitation sent to all the National Federations.

Here you can find the Covid-19 Protocol set by the Fiemme Organizing Committee:

- Individual responsibility is the most important aspect for the safety of everyone.
- All competitors must follow the **basic hygiene measures**, to prevent the spread of Covid-19 infection:
  1. **Keep the minimum distance of 1m**
  2. **Wear a mask always inside and outside (*only if you have not the possibility to hold the minimum distance*)**
  3. **Wash and disinfect frequently your hands**



- Anybody who should show symptoms of Covid-19 during the event must contact immediately the OC, informing the Race Office at the following number +39 347 5579293
- For all foreign athletes and media, please visit the [Italian Ministry website](#) > before coming to Val di Fiemme, to be updated regarding the travel restrictions.

- Do not travel to Val di Fiemme if you have symptoms of Covid-19.
- During your stay in Val di Fiemme, please try to avoid any contact with other people outside the competition venue.
- A **Covid-19 test (PCR is required)** must be done by all athletes, team staff, officials, SRS and media **within 72 hours** before their arrival at the competition venue (or proof of positive PCR test between 6 months and two weeks prior to arrival and free of symptoms), and the negative result of this test must be uploaded on the **FIS Passport**. *The PCR test is required in any case, also to fully vaccinated people.* The accreditations will be released only once the Organising Committee imports the result of the negative PCR tests from the FIS Passport.
- Like for all other FIS competitions, please remember that you will be asked also to answer the **health questionnaire** on your FIS Passport.

These guidelines regarding Covid-19 prevention protocol have been defined according to the FIS Covid-19 Prevention Guidelines and to the Italian national and local regulations updated on 30th July 2021.

The OC reserves the right to make any necessary change if some new rules, regarding Covid-19, will be released by the national or local authorities.
