### 6-7-8 JANUARY 2023



The Covid-19 pandemic is still affecting our lives, and even if the situation all over the world seems to go slowly better thanks to the vaccination campaign, we all have to be very careful and act in a responsible way: individual responsibility is the most important aspect for the safety of everyone. The LOC of Val di Fiemme strongly recommends all the stakeholders involved in the event to respect scrupulously all the basic hygiene rules, in order to avoid as much as possible, the risk of contagion during the final stages of Tour de Ski 2023 in Val di Fiemme:

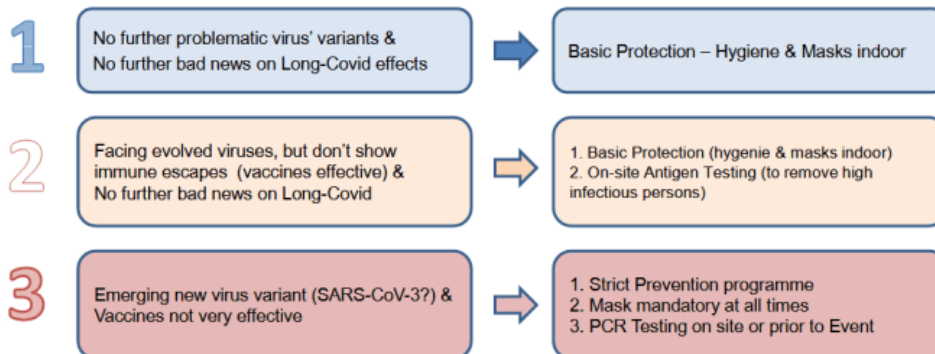
1. Keep the minimum distance of 1m whenever possible
2. Wash and disinfect frequently your hands
3. Wear a mask when you are in an indoor space with other people



For the winter season 2022/2023 FIS Medical Covid-19 Support group has prepared the following matrix that will be used according to the situation present at each event location. In any case, prevention will remain the main driver for FIS in securing the events and making sure that all involved parties are feeling safe before, during, and after the competitions. The three scenarios presented in the chart are based on the experience from the past seasons and the recommendations given by the experts. The monitoring during the season will take a fundamental role, and according to the situation, FIS will activate one of the presented actions. The LOC in Val di Fiemme is obviously ready and well prepared with all necessary tools in order to face any of the 3 scenarios:
