REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

The competition is regulated by the **Regolamento Tecnico Federale** (Technical Rules of the Italian Ski Federation), and it is included in the federal calendar FisiOnline.

FOREIGN ATHLETES: all athletes must be born earlier than 04.01.2004 (they must be 18 years old on the competition day). All competitiors will be asked to show their identity card or passport when picking up their bibs.

The **registrations** must be done on our web site, at the following link:

https://fiemmeworldcup.com/en/tourdeski/ee/303596/rampa-con-i-campioni.php.; they will open from Friday, 19th November 2021, and will close on Sunday 2nd January 2022. The Organizing Committee could anticipate the closing date for entries when the maximum number of 200 competitors is reached

By sending his/her entry, any participant must supply the Organiser with all the information requested on the entry form. Any incomplete form will not be accepted. Once the competitor has completed the online registration, he/she will receive a confirmation e-mail.

ENTRY FEE

No registration will be accepted without the payment of the **entry fee of 25,00 €**, that all the competitors will be asked to pay once they have completed the online registration procedure.

The payment must be done **through bank money transfer**, and the registration will be then considered complete only when a **copy of the payment** is sent via e-mail to info@fiemmeworldcup.com or fax to the number +39 0462 352091. Entry fees will neither be returned for any reason nor considered valid for next editions. The copy of payment must be sent within midnight of Sunday 2nd January 2022.

TEAM CAPTAINS' MEETING

The Team Captains' Meeting will be held **online** on Monday 3rd January 2022, starting time TBC.

BIBS DISTRIBUTION

Bibs will be distributed at the race office, set up inside the accreditation office at the cross country stadium in Lago di Tesero (access allowed only with valid Green Pass or equivalent document), on Monday 3rd January from 14.30 to 18.30 and on Tuesday 4th January from 7.00 to 9.00.

In order to get the starting bib, each competitor must present his/her identity card or passport and fill in the self-declaration Covid-19, that can be downloaded when sending the registration form, or that competitors can find directly at the race office.

PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

The prize giving ceremony will take place at the finish area on Alpe Cermis at the end of the competition.

The top 3 athletes of the following categories will be awarded:

- Overall men (born before 04.01.2004)
- Overall women (born before 04.01.2004)

RULES

In addition to the regulations included in the Technical Rules of the Italian Ski Federation, also the dispositions of the Agenda degli Sport Invernali 2021/2022 (Winter Sport Agenda) will be applied to the competition. All these rules are available on the web site www.fisi.org.

OTHER GENERAL INFORMATION

INSURANCE POLICY

It is the duty of each participant to verify the coverage of his/her own sports insurance policy in case of accident or damage to others during the competition.

By sending the entry form, all competitors explicitly declare to exempt the organizers from every responsibility, both civil and criminal, for damages to people and/or things, caused by him or suffered by him.

DOPING CONTROLS

In full compliance with all the rules of the Agenda degli Sport Invernali 2021/2022, any possible doping control will take place at the Cross Country Stadium in Lago di Tesero.

COVID-19

The competition is organised in full compliance with the Covid-19 Protocol of the Italian Ski Federation. The current version is published here: https://www.fisi.org/wp-content/uploads/Protocollo-COVID-19-FISI-Gare_Federali_stagione_2021_2022.pdf

When picking up their bibs, all competitors will be asked to fill in the self-declaration Covid-19, that can be downloaded when sending the registration form, or that they can find directly at the race office.

In addition to the Covid-19 prevention protocol of the Italian Ski Federation, the Organising Committee also asks all the competitors to have the Covid-19 Green pass as a mandatory document, necessary to take part in the competition. The green pass must be uploaded on the personal profile that each competitor will have to create while making the registration (some days before the race, the Organising Committe will send a proper link, that athletes can use to make the upload), or it can be presented, either in paper or digital version, at the race office while picking up the bib.

Alternatively, for people who don't have the green pass, it will be necessary to upolad or present (with the same procedure described above), **one of the following documents,** that must be valid on the competition day:

- Covid-19 vaccination certificate
- Certificate of recovery from Covid-19 valid for 6 months from the end of the isolation
- A negative Covid-19 test (PCR or rapid test), not older than 48 hours before the start of the competition

OTHER INFORMATION FROM OC

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

In order to take part in the competition, all participants must:

- Be at least 18 years of age on the competition day (born before 04.01.2004);
- Have read the present Rules before the start;
- Respect the safety and competition regulations foreseen by the present Rules;
- Be perfectly aware of the risks involved by participating in this event. Sending their entries, the
 participants declare they have considered the risks related to their participation, perfectly aware of
 their physical and technical skills;
- Have the proper technical equipment for the competition, that must be in compliance with the characteristics requested by the current FISI rules. All competitors must undergo the technical controls made before the start.

EVENTS OF FORCE MAJEURE

The Organiser won't be responsible if the competition will be modified, shortened or cancelled due to an event of force majeure or independent from its control. Events of force majeure include: safety reasons, atmospheric phenomena, health reasons connected to Covid-19 pandemic or to other health emergencies, and unforeseen events unrelated to the will of the Organiser, and which could compromise the good execution of the event. All competitors will be informed about any change to these Rules, including any cause of force majeure, on the event's web site. The changes will be considered part of the present Rules. Any change of the Rules will be considered accepted by all participants when sending their entries for the competition. In case of cancellation of the event, the organising committee won't reimburse the entry fee to the participants.

RACE EQUIPMENT

The athletes will have to compete using ski that must be in compliance with the characteristics requested by the current rules of the Italian Ski Federation.

FEEDING ZONES

One feeding zone will be set up at the finish area in respect of the Covid-19 protocol.

BIBS

The race bibs must be visible throughout the entire duration of the race, without being covered by any piece of cloth.

ACCESS ROAD TO ALPE CERMIS

The road that connects Masi di Cavalese to Alpe Cermis (finish area), will be closed for vehicles for the entire day of Tuesday 4th January 2022.

RESULT LISTS

The following result lists will be prepared:

- Overall men (born before 04.01.2004)
- Overall women (born before 04.01.2004)

All result lists will be published on the web site of the Organising Committee <u>www.fiemmerollerskicup.it</u> and on the web site of the Italian Ski Federation (both National and Provincial).

PROTESTS

Any protest must be presented on the proper form, according to the FISI rules. Each protest must be handed over together with a deposit of $50 \in$, that will be returned in case the protest itself is accepted.

DISPUTES

The competition is regulated by the FISI Rules and the present Rules, and the participants are obliged to conform these rules.

TREATMENT OF PERSONAL DATA

All personal data, that each competitor has to send with the registration, can be handled by the Organiser, with the procedure and for the purposes established in art. 13 and 14 of the G.D.P.R. (EU Rules 679/2016 about treatment of personal data).

Personal data collected at this competition are registered electronically and used by the Organizer with the following purposes: competition management, distribution of prizes and promotion of other sport events that could be interesting for the participants.

CONSENT FORM / AUTHORISATION TO PUBLISH PICTURES AND VIDEO FOR PROMOTIONAL PURPOSES

By sending their entries, all participants authorize the Organiser to use, for free and without any limit of time, also according to articles 10 and 320 of the Italian "Codice Civile", and to articles 96 and 97 of the law n. 633 22.04.1941, Law about copyright, the live transmission and the publication and/or distribution of their images (pictures and video), on printed material and/or on any other means of distribution.
