

MARCIALONGA 2027 RULES

32 KM T.C. JUST FOR FUN

1) The Marcialonga 32 km Just for Fun is a NON-competitive event taking place on the last Sunday in January over a distance of 32 km.

2) Competitors of both sexes who have reached the age of 16 and who hold a non-competitive medical certificate are eligible to take part in the race.

3) Registrations must be made online and must include all the required details. Registrations will not be accepted without payment of the entry fee. Registration entitles participants to take part in the event, to use transport (subject to booking), technical support, refreshment points, waxing stations, transport of clothing from the start to the finish (maximum weight 3 kg, insured value equal to the registration fee paid) and services at the finish. All other expenses are the responsibility of the competitor.

4) The registration fee is set at:

€90.00 from 3 June 2026 to 31 August 2026

€104.00 from 1 September 2026 to 31 November 2026

€114.00 from 1 December 2026 to 10 January 2027

€124.00 from 11 January 2027 to 28 January 2028 (deadline)

Should you be unable to take part, the Organising Committee offers the option of transferring the entry fee paid (but not the race number) to another competitor of the same nationality. The request must be sent in writing by the person transferring the entry to the secretariat. The transfer has a cost of €20.00 until 11 January and €30.00 from 12 to 20 January, the deadline for requests.

This procedure involves a transfer of the entry fee only, not the race number, which will be reallocated based on the new competitor's results.

Requests to change race distance will be accepted by 20 January, subject to the availability of race numbers, and are subject to a fee of €20.00, payable to the race office in Cavalese.

The exchange of race numbers is not permitted; doing so will result in disqualification and a ban on participation for the following two years for both the registered competitor and the competitor who took part.

The entry fee is non-refundable under any circumstances and cannot be carried over to subsequent editions.

5) Race numbers will be collected from the race office in Cavalese (Palafiemme).

- THURSDAY 3.00 pm – 7.00 pm

- FRIDAY 9.00 am – 7.00 pm

- SATURDAY 9.00 am – 7.00 pm

When collecting your race number, you will be asked to present your ID.

6) A single-use chip is attached to the race number to record your start and finish times. The chip is located on the back, so any rucksack must be worn underneath the race number so as not to interfere with its operation.

7) Timing is compulsory.

In the start area, you may hand in your bag, which must have a sticker bearing your race number attached to it.

8) The start in Moena is scheduled for 11.00.

9) The use of fluorinated products is prohibited and will result in disqualification. Random checks will be carried out to verify that the materials used are compliant.

10) Only the classic technique is permitted: the use of the freestyle technique will result in disqualification by the marshals stationed along the entire course. It is strictly forbidden to remove one's skis during the race, and there is no right of 'clear run' for those wishing to overtake another competitor. Only one ski may be replaced. The Jury is authorised to impose penalties or disqualify competitors who breach these regulations. Competitors who stray from the course or who, in the opinion of the medical officer, are unable to continue will be considered out of the race.

11) Time controls are scheduled at: Predazzo at 15.50 and Località Cascata (km 61 – outbound) at 17.30. Closing times may be subject to change to ensure the safety of competitors. Further time controls may be established at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

12) Refreshment points are marked on the elevation profile. To protect the environment, it is forbidden to litter along the routes; rubbish must be disposed of in the designated bins located near the refreshment points and/or at the finish line. Anyone caught by the organising staff and/or race marshals failing to comply with this rule will be disqualified or penalised at the discretion of the jury.

13) All finishers will be awarded a participation medal.

The following facilities will be available in the finish area: first-aid post, ski storage, refreshments, cloakroom, changing rooms, buses to various towns, a pasta party (at the Palafiemme in Cavalese until 18.30) and showers (at the municipal swimming pool in Cavalese until 18.30).

14) In the event of force majeure, the Organising Committee reserves the right to alter the route without restriction or to cancel the race. In the latter case, entrants will be entitled to a 50% discount on the entry fee for the following edition.

15) Each competitor acknowledges for all intents and purposes that the Marcialonga requires considerable physical and technical commitment. By registering, they implicitly declare, under their own responsibility, that they meet these requirements.

16) The Organising Committee is authorised to impose penalties or disqualify competitors found to have behaved in an unsporting manner during the event, including throwing rubbish outside the designated bins. The Organising Committee also reserves the right to carry out random checks on competitors to ensure that they have not taken any prohibited stimulants.

17) By submitting their entry, competitors declare that they are fully aware of and accept these rules in their entirety, as well as any amendments required to comply with current legislation; they also expressly declare that they release the organisers from all liability, both civil and criminal, for any damage to persons and/or property caused by them or arising from their actions. In matters not covered herein, the F.I.S. international regulations for Granfondo promotional races shall apply.
