

RULES

Art.1: The Vintage Cross Country Ski Book **(VCCSB)** is designed to safeguard the history of the old cross-country skis, with special characteristics, built in different historical periods, real heritage of the winter sports.

Art.2: For registration only cross-country skis, in wood or plastic and manufactured before 1976 (period characterised by the transition from 75mm to 35mm), will be considered.

Art.3: The VCCSB will contain the following info: details of the owner and of the skis, brand, model and year of construction, the height, serial number and colour. It will also be taken into consideration the bindings and the preservation status. If authorized, personal data of the owner will be recorded.

Art.4: The registration request can be sent during the year, by filling in the entry form and sending it with high resolution photo of the ski to Marcialonga:

Art.5: The skis will be verified by a commission of experts made up of collectors. The presentation of the skis can be done the days before Marcialonga cross country ski race, at the race office in Cavalese. The exact day and time table will be published on the official program of the event.

Art.6: For each pair of skis a copy of the registration certificate will be released together with a small number plate indicating the registration number that must be placed on the skis.

Art.7: The skis can be registered only once. Any transfer of ownership of the skis will be considered only if requested by the initial owner.

Art.8: The entry in the **VCCSB** does not imply annual costs and does not need to be renewed. Only a minimum contribution, set annually, will be requested for the initial registration of the skis.

Art. 9: The VCCSB will be kept at the Marcialonga office and published on www.marcialonga.it
