

REGULATIONS LAVAZELOPPET



1. The U.S. LAVAZE' of Varena organizes the 45th Edition of the Lavazeloppet, an international cross-country race of 22 km in CLASSIC TECHNIQUE.
2. The race will take place at the Lavazè Pass on Thursday, January 25, 2024 with a line start at 9:30 am. Athletes of both genders who have reached the age of 18 and are F.I.S.I. members or in possession of a suitable medical certificate may participate in the race.
3. Entries can be made by filling out the appropriate form on the U.S. Lavazè website at the following link <https://www.uslavaze.com/iscrizione-lavazeloppet/> . At the same time the payment of €40 via credit card will be requested as registration fee. Registration will be closed on January 24, 2024 or when the number of 400 registrants is reached.
4. The distribution of bibs will take place at the Lavazè Pass Race Office on Tuesday, 23.01 from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. and Wednesday, 24.01 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. On race day, the Race Office will be open from 7:30 am. A free gadget is provided for each participant.
5. Jury meeting will be held on January 24 at the Race Office at 4 pm.
6. The start of the race is set for 9:30 a.m. on January 25, 2024; at 9:00 a.m. competitors should report to the start for punching. The starting zone will be divided into two groups. The first group may include: the top 50 finishers in the 2024 edition, athletes under 100 F.I.S.I. points and from the various national teams.
7. Checkpoints will be set up along the course to enforce race technique. Competitors who do not comply with the Classic Technique established by these regulations will be disqualified. There is no right to free track. The maximum time is set at 3 hours and 30 minutes.
8. Results will be published on: www.uslavaze.com, www.marcialonga.it and Facebook Lavazeloppet.
9. Any complaints must be submitted to the Jury within the terms established by the R.T.F. and accompanied by the fee of € 50.00, refundable in case of acceptance of the complaint.
10. Prizes will be awarded to the top 5 finishers in the men's category and the top 5 in the women's category.
11. For all matters not covered in these Regulations, please refer to the provisions of the R.T.F. and the rules issued regarding F.I.S. cross-country races.
12. The Organization, committing itself to the success of the event, declines all responsibility for damages to persons/things that may occur before, during and after the event itself.
13. Should the race be cancelled for any reason, the organization agrees to return the entry fee or keep it good for the following year.
